DIRECTIONS TO CHOATE ROSEMARY HALL

For those with GPS the address is:

Choate Rosemary Hall
333 Christian Street
Wallingford, CT 06492

From the North or South on the Merritt Parkway (7 minutes from exit)

- Exit 64 - Wallingford.
- RIGHT end of Ramp.
- Follow Quinnipiac Street to Center Street (Quinnipiac turns into Center at Wallace Park – bear left at the light at Wallace Park) all the way up the hill through the center of town about 1.5 miles. (If you get to Dairy Queen you forgot to bear left at Wallace Park.)
- LEFT on Elm Street.
- Follow signs to parking at Choate (there are multiple places to park).

From the North heading South on I91 (4 minutes from exit)

- Exit 14 - Woodhouse Avenue.
- RIGHT end of Ramp.
- Straight about 1.5 miles to East Side Market.
- RIGHT at East Side Market onto East Main Street.
- LEFT at Regency House and Cemetery onto Christian Street.
- Choate Football Field will be on your left. Please follow signs for parking.

From the South heading North on I91 (5 minutes from exit)

- Exit 14 - Woodhouse Avenue.
- LEFT end of Ramp (the ramps are different north and south on I91 for Wallingford).
- Straight on Woodhouse Avenue to light at East Side Market.
- Stay STRAIGHT through light. It turns into East Main Street.
- LEFT at Regency House and Cemetery onto Christian Street.
- Choate Football Field will be on your left. Please follow signs for parking.

Choate is beautiful and to keep its fields that way... carpooling is STRONGLY encouraged.
